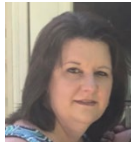
ROAD SAFETY by *John Laing*

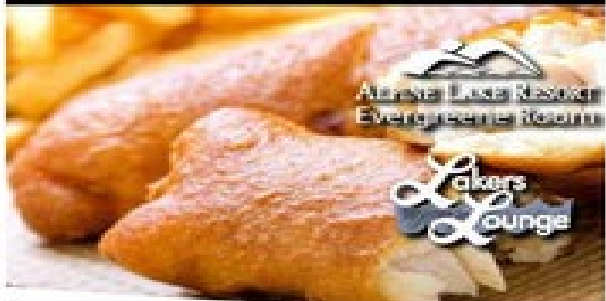
